Supplying Bulk Explosives to Other Sites

What are the requirements for supplying bulk explosives to a non-mine/quarry operation?

- Follow the current Terms and Conditions on your licence;
- If QD cannot be met QRA (ex, road jobs);
- More to come This topic is under review.



Quantity-Distance Exemptions

(to supersede *Derogations*)

What are the expected criteria for a QD Exemption?

- Expected = Meet QD Standard
 - QRA to support Exemption
 - Other risk-based approaches
 - Engineered measures
- ➤ Submit proposal to ERD
- ➤ More to come....



QD to Power Lines



"IMESAFR cannot be used to address QD to power lines. What is ERD's position regarding risk analysis to power lines that do not meet QD?"

➤ ERD is willing to review other quantitative approaches.



Update on work related to consideration of UN3375 for the Transportation of Specific ANE





eLMS

- Gap analysis conducted by third party.
- Report submitted and under review.
- No timelines established yet.





Other Questions:

- Annual Reporting requirements may change under the ongoing regulatory review.
- **Physical Surveillance of Magazines:** Unless otherwise specified on your licence, daily checks are required.
- Fuel Storage (as per the QD Standard):
 - When < 10,000 L = Min. 8 m away; or
 - When > 10,000 L = Min. 25 m away.
- When Guidelines and/or Standards do not align, contact ERD.
- No formal timeline for the review of the QD Standard.
- Definition of Surface Blasting or Mining Operation is a work in progress. More to come.
- Handling of Carloads of Explosives on Railway Trackage Regulations SOR/79-15: Please contact the authority having jurisdiction for questions relating to these regulations (Transport Canada).





Factory Licence Renewal Reminders

- Site and Area plans must match Form E.
- Include all Exposed Sites on Form E (e.g. fuel storage).
- Highlight any changes on Forms B-E to make it easier to review (remove highlights from previous amendments).
- Form C must indicate all client sites including road jobs, etc.
- Security Plan is a mandatory document to update and submit for each renewal.
- Submit all forms and plans in PDF format, if possible.





Shared (/Y) Magazine Licence Reminders

- Main licence holder is responsible for the shared licence holder's explosives during storage (including inventory, etc.).
- Shared licence holder is not permitted access to magazine keys.
- Shared licence holder must be accompanied / under supervision of main licence holder at all times while accessing the magazines.
- Exemptions may be granted to the above if shared magazine only contains shared licence holder's product. This requires a shared agreement letter to this effect, and resulting terms and conditions on the licence to reflect the exemption (ERD must approve).





Temporary Authorizations (TAs)

- TAs were originally intended for last-minute, short duration situations such as personnel-limit increases or emergency work within D5 at a mine site.
- ERD has been receiving many personnel limit increase TAs. This indicates personnel limits on certain licences are not appropriate for site operations.
- ERD has also been receiving requests for TAs that are months in duration. These will not be accepted. Such situations should be submitted as Exemption requests supported by QRA.
- Last year it was agreed with CEAEC that TAs could be used to grant MPU swaps between factories for no more than 30 days. This remains the policy.
