UN0332 to UN3375

ERD and Transport Canada have met to discuss classifying unsensitized bulk emulsion as an oxidizer.

The primary hurdle is that UN3375 is classified as “forbidden” to transport

Transport Canada is assembling a committee on the topic and CEAEC is requesting to participate
