Suggested changes to Explosives Regulations

Transporting Other Items with Explosives

- CEAEC suggested that the ERD amend Part 9, 192(3)(a)(b) referring to the transport of non-explosive items with more than 2000 kgs explosives and the permit required to do so.
- (a) in the case of a vehicle that contains no more than 10 kg of explosives, the things are stowed, or separated from, the explosives so as to minimize the likelihood of an ignition.
- (b) in the case of a vehicle that contains more than 10 kg of explosives, the vehicle has been authorized to transport the things by a permit issued by the Minister under paragraph 7(1)(b) of the Explosives Act and the permit is in the vehicle.
